Our staff has put great focus and energy into each student's success again this year. As we get ready for next school year, there will be a few changes. A new school website will be ready for the start of the year. We are coordinating a new call home system and electronic database, too. The electronic database will allow parents/guardians to review, input, change information electronically instead of getting cramps in your hands from writing out all student information on paper. Look for more information to be put forward soon.

Our food service department supplied great options for students again. Janet Mendenhall and her crew continue to look for ways to provide nutritious options for students. Food prices will most likely remain the same for the next school year. This would be the same price as it was in the 2010-2011 school year. In order for prices to remain the same, the district must apply and receive a waiver from the federal government. We have applied for and received the waiver the past three years. I expect

we will receive the waiver again this year. If not, lunch prices will go up by \$.10 per lunch.

On May 25th at 6:30 p.m., there will be a meeting at the Board of Education office to review updated board policy on testing. Following Senate Bill 3, testing and practice is capped at 2 and 1 percent of the school year. Versailles EVSD would like input on the policy to continue to allow staff flexibility to meet the needs of students.

The Athletic Department will be offering all season sports passes to students for \$25 during the 2017-2018 school year. By decreasing prices for students, the Athletic Department hopes students and families are able to attend more events. This is a pilot program for this school year and will be reevaluated at the end of the next school year.

Thanks to the Diamond Club, Friends of Hole Field, Music Boosters, Athletic Boosters, PTO and the entire community for making this another successful year at Versailles Schools. As you look around at district resources, anyone would be hard pressed to find better facilities for student learning and activities.
