- ◆ approve a change order in the amount of \$68,556.00 to Peterson Construction Company #SFC1061-4206 for the purpose of changing restroom floors in C150, C151, D129, D130, C208, C209, D216 and D217 from ceramic tile to terrazzo.

In items of discussion, the daily schedule for students when we move to the new building was brought up with concerns to bus pick-up times, length of classes, and dismissal time. This is one of the many adjustments being looked into as we prepare for the transition. Also discussed were plumbing and heating concerns at the North Star building that have been inspected, repaired and will continued to be monitored.
