Horatio Alger Scholarship- Is open to students who are enrolled full-time as a high school senior in the United States, with plans to enter a college in the United States no later than the fall following graduation, exhibit a strong commitment to pursue and complete a **bachelor's degree** at an accredited non-profit public or private institution in the United States (students may start their studies at a two-year institution and then transfer to a four-year institution), demonstrate critical financial need (\$55,000 or lower adjusted gross family income is required), be involved in co-curricular and community service activities, display integrity and perseverance in overcoming adversity, maintain a minimum grade point average (GPA) of 2.0, and be a United States citizen- See more at: <https://scholars.horatioalger.org/scholarships/> **Deadline is Oct 26.**

The Coca-Cola Scholars Program Scholarship- is an achievement-based scholarship awarded to graduating high school seniors each year. Students are recognized for their capacity to lead and serve, and their commitment to making a significant impact on their schools and communities.
