

Preliminary Testing Data

Preliminary testing data from Spring of 2015 PARCC (ELA and MATH) and AIR (Science and Social Studies) has finally arrived. These tests were taken on computers for the first time. In addition, the PARCC tests will not be used any longer. AIR will start providing all testing starting this school year.

The District's proficiency rates are listed below. There were some drops in proficiency rates compared to previous years. This was expected as the new tests were created to be more challenging. However, our scores did not drop as much as predicted by the state and are still much greater than the state averages. These preliminary results are the basis for the district's report card and performance index.
